THE COLOURED HOCKEY LEAGUE OF THE MARITIMES



BETWEEN THE YEARS OF 1895-1935 THE COLOURED HOCKEY LEAGUE OF THE MARITIMES (CHLM) OPERATED IN NEW BRUNSWICK, NEW JERSEY, AND PENN. THE PLAYERS IN ITS TEAMS WERE LARGELY THE SONS AND GRANDSONS OF REPAIRED SLAVES THAT HAD ESCAPED TO THE MARITIMES THROUGH THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD. THE CHLM WAS A SMALL BUT POWERFUL LEAGUE IN THAT MANY OF HOCKEY'S FOREMOST NAMES WERE FIRST INSTALLED. THE SLAPSHOT AND GOALTENDERS LEAVING THEIR FEET TO MAKE A SAVE AND PLACING THE PUCK WERE ALL INSTALLED IN THE CHLM. IT WOULD BE ANOTHER 20 YEARS AFTER THE BEGINNING OF THE CHLM BEFORE PROGRESSIVE WHITE HOCKEY WOULD BE IN THE BLACK (OR GREY) HATRED OF THE NHL.
